Our Inclusive Team

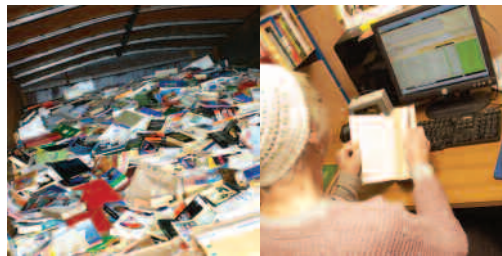
We established an innovative **'Total Team Model'**. This is based on supporting people who have found difficulty in obtaining employment through disability, illness or personal circumstances.

- **80%** of our staff have experienced long-term unemployment
- **30%** of the team has a disability or medical condition
- We provide **dozens** of flexible work placements and volunteering opportunities each year



Our Commitment

- Each week we collect **tonnes** of used books from **dozens** of charities, community groups and libraries
- We are an internet based bookseller selling to customers both in the **UK** and **Worldwide**
- We raise **£10,000s** every year for these suppliers
- We give away **100s** of free books every month, through our **'Books For All'** initiative



Our Environmental Strategy

- All of our books are **re-used or recycled: none go to landfill**
- Every year we divert 1,000s of **tonnes** of unwanted books from landfill
